<p>Meals</p>	<p>Shared kitchens are available on each floor of the student residences (kitchenware not provided).</p> <p>University restaurants and cafeterias on each campus. One restaurant always open on weekends and holidays. Student rate: €3.40 (= 6 points)</p>

<p>Insurance</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➔ Housing insurance with third-party liability: Mandatory, to be subscribed on arrival - about €30 ➔ Health insurance: International health insurance plan to be subscribed <u>BEFORE your arrival</u>, covering all the duration of the stay and including repatriation.
<p>Budget</p>	<p>Student average monthly expenses is approx. €720, included meals and transportation pass.</p>
