## Innovation Pool Funds for inter-/transdisciplinary projects

Funding available: Up to €25,000

**Project period:** Must begin within 12 months of approval **Application deadline:** 15<sup>th</sup> January 2026, 12:00 (midday)

#### **Program overview**

We are excited to announce funding for **inter- and transdisciplinary research projects** that foster collaboration across disciplines in the field of land use and resilience and engage relevant stakeholders. This programme supports innovative projects that combine expertise from at least two principal investigators (PIs) from different fields and have a clear plan for scientific and/or societal output. At least one of the PIs needs to be from the University of Göttingen.

#### What we offer

**Funding:** Up to €25,000 for project-related costs (including materials and personnel); several small projects possible

#### What we expect

**Collaboration:** At least two PIs from different fields, at least one PI needs to be from the University of Göttingen

**Stakeholder Engagement:** Strong integration of external stakeholders (e.g., industry, public sector, NGOs) is encouraged

**Output:** Projects should aim for tangible outcomes such as publications, workshops, or new methods

### **Application requirements**

Please submit a **2-page project proposal** (use template) plus reference CVs for all PIs including:

- Project Title and Summary
- Participating PIs and Disciplines: At least two PIs from different fields
- Project Objectives and Methodology
- Stakeholder Involvement: Describe how stakeholders will be integrated
- Expected Output: Scientific and/or practical outcomes
- Timeline: Project milestones and deliverables
- Budget Overview: Outline of planned use of funds
